

F10 MKII Fire Fighting & Rescue Helmets

The Pacific F10MKII Fire Fighting and Rescue helmet system gives the fire fighter and professional rescuer the most up-to-date and modern form of head protection in a very comfortable, lightweight and wearable package.

Manufactured from Kevlar reinforced composite shells, the F10MKII Structural Fire Fighting helmet and the F10MKII Compact offer the perfect combination of safety, balance and wearer comfort. A jet-style design ensures that the F10MKII range is not only functional but looks good too.

Use of fibre-reinforced materials means the helmets have less mass than those manufactured from thermo plastics. A lightweight helmet ensures all users can concentrate on their job rather than neck ache.

Use of composites also means that the helmets last and last. Tests prove helmets that have been in service for over 10 years still pass stringent EN443 testing.

The F10MKII helmet system is manufactured with the UK fire market in mind. BA clips are not attached as they are not used in the UK. The F10 MKII helmets are therefore very clean looking with no slots or pockets to catch or in which to collect debris.

Extreme Eye and Face Protection

The unique 'One-Touch' eye-guard feature means that contaminated hands need not interfere with operation of eye protection nor does it mean the use of fiddly knobs with cumbersome fire fighting gloves. If preferred, a manually operated version can be supplied.

The Structural Fire Fighting Helmet represents all of the features a fire fighter would expect in a modern helmet. The large integral bubble visor offers excellent peripheral vision with zero distortion.



Manufactured from tough, scratch resistant polycarbonate and meeting EN14458, when not in use it slots neatly under the helmet protecting it from contamination and damage.

The unique 'One touch' eye guard avoids the need to operate fiddly knobs or dials on the side of the helmet. Simply pushing up on the integral eye guard deploys the EN 166 eye protector. The 'One-Touch' mechanism has been subjected to extensive user trials and its operation has been tested over 100,000 times with zero failure.

Torches

The sturdy and versatile torch bracket system allows fire services to select their preferred helmet-mounted torch. VimpeX recommend the UK (Underwater Kinetics) 3 or 4 AA torches, which are ATEX approved and fully waterproof. Torches can be branded with individual fire service logos if required. This can either be pad printed or for larger quantities incorporated into plastic mouldings.



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
